Potential Therapy Funding Sources

Below is a list of potential therapy funding resources. If you are in need of assistance in pursuing these options, we are here to help!

- **Catalyst Farm Superbills:** Although we do not accept insurance, we are happy to provide patients with a superbill following each session. The superbill is a detailed receipt and can be submitted to insurance for potential out-of-network reimbursement.
- **Flex Spending Accounts:** FSA, HSA, and HRA money can be used to pay for therapy
- **Board of Developmental Disabilities:** We have many families who come with funding from their county's board. Call your local office to see what funding is available to you.
- **Children with Medical Handicaps Program:** a health care program in the Ohio Department of Health that helps families obtain payment for the services their children need
- **School District:** your local school district may offer funding for therapy services outside of school, especially during summer break
- **PASSS:** provides funding to help cover services for adopted children
- **Gift Cards:** we offer gift cards that can be used to cover therapy or camp expenses. This is a great option for family and friends who are looking for a way to help!

Non-Profits offering grants and/or scholarships

- **Autism Care Today:** raises awareness and provides treatment services and support to families to help their children with autism achieve their full potential
- **CARE Family Grant Program:** helps families with medication, autism diagnosis/evaluation, therapy sessions, and autism summer camps
- **Doc's Deepwood Run Foundation:** provides grants and gifts to enhance the quality of life of persons with developmental disabilities
- **First Hand Foundation:** children receive access to needed care and to health and wellness program, allowing them to thrive and succeed
- **Groovy Garfoose:** funds music therapy sessions
- **Maggie Welby Foundation:** grants for children and families in need of help with bills, athletic opportunities, medical needs, or an opportunity that a child would not otherwise have
- **MyGOAL Inc:** enables families to take advantage of socialization and educational opportunities designed for individuals with special needs
- **Small Steps in Speech:** provides grants on behalf of children with speech and language disorders for therapies, treatments, communicative devices, and other services aimed at improving their communication skills
- **Special Kids Therapy:** provides family scholarships to cover the cost of equipment or therapies and activities that are not funded by insurances or other agencies
- **The Upside of Downs:** grants awarded to assist in paying medical expenses, including therapy
- **UHCCF Grants:** helps families gain access to the care they need through medical grants
- **Zane's Foundation:** helps children and adults with special needs through education and financial support
